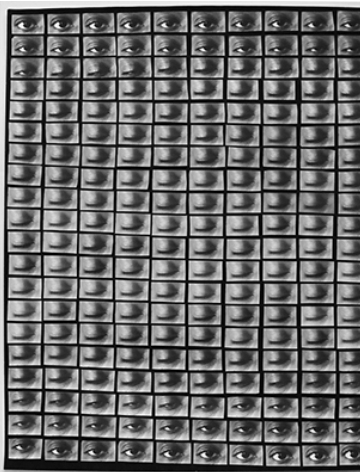
Use this guide front and back to inspire writing and action using photography.

Question

What do you **wonder** about the eyes in this image?

Connection

Visual artist, Dionne Lee, explores the racial memory embedded within the American landscape, using recurring objects, such as eyes, as witnesses of the land. Identify a social issue that your eyes have been witness to personally.

Interpret

How do the use of eyes support the artist's message about memory and witness of the American Landscape?

RESPOND

Inspired by Dionne Lee's artwork frame your thoughts and perspectives on a social issue you have witnessed.

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WRITE IT

Write a speech about a social issue that has personally affected you. Share why it is important to you, and how you have changed your life to address the issue. What would you say to encourage others to make a change?

PICTURE IT

Compose photographic art based on your dream. What ideas do you have? What materials or space will you use to make this image? Outline and sketch it here.
